WHAT IS ECOFASCISM?



People often mean different things when they say "ecofascism":

- Theory: any synthesis of far-right "blood and soil" politics with environmentalism which scapegoats minority/marginalized groups.
- Practice: Fascists using environmental issues in order to perform entryism, mask their activities, platform fascist ideas, and gain credibility.
- Misapplication: the practice of calling any direct action to protect the environment "ecofascist".

CALL FOR ACTION AND AWARENESS:

- Guard against any fascists or far-right individuals who are attempting to capitalize on the popular momentum of Defend the Forest. One example is the Boogers or "Boogaloo Boys" who previously tried to use BLM and the George Floyd Uprising to whitewash their racism and platform their ridiculous anarcho-capitalist ideology. Some of them have now pivoted to environmental causes. Many "Boogaloo Boys" have explicit neo-Nazi connections.
- Look out for and avoid accidentally promoting fascist symbology when promoting direct actions.
- Look up the concept of the "three-way fight" and remember that even when fascists say they hate the cops, it's only because they want to eventually become the cops. Never view them as allies of convenience.

Symbols commonly used by neo-Nazis:



The numbers "14", "88", and "1488" are commonly used by white supremacists.

Other fascist symbology includes the pine tree emoji, although this is also used by non-fascists. They will use "Uncle Adolf" to refer to Adolf Hitler. "Hawaiian" shirts, hibiscus flowers, and igloo symbols are commonly used by Boogaloo Boys.
